## MALAYSIA'S NORTHERN TRANSPORTATION HUB



Penang Sentral, the one stop transportation hub, opened its doors in November 2018.

Located in Butterworth, Penang, it serves as an integrated system connecting KTM's Electric Train Service (ETS) and Komuter train services, intercity, express and stage bus services, taxi and ferry services. Bus passengers can now buy their tickets themselves at the self-service ticketing machine which is way more convenient than queuing in line!

# A WALK THROUGH ART

## BUTTERWORTH ART WALK



Ever since Ernest Zacharevic's wall murals impressed many back in 2012, the street art scene in Penang began to bloom. In recent years, Butterworth has emerged as a city of art with the now famous Butterworth Art Walk, an alley with walls filled with beautiful vibrant murals.

Butterworth started to develop in this direction because of its participation in the Urban Xchange Festival in 2015, which large-scale public murals were produced.





**The collaborative mural by Penangite Abdulrashade and Malacca-based artist Andharas depicts a local artisan painting Batik, a prized intangible heritage in Malaysia. Making batik involves several processes including applying wax to the cloth, dyeing or painting and drying. Despite its time-consuming processes, some passionate artisans remain loyal to this traditional craftsmanship and still insist on handcrafting batik to conserve the traditional art.**





*The mural depicts a fisherman pushing his boat into the water with his last remaining energy. His passion and love for the job is the burning fire inside the fisherman, pushing him into the wild waters every day to face his daily challenges. This mural is a compelling visual story about the fire inside us to pursue our passion and love, no matter the circumstance, no matter the exhaustion, no matter the danger.*

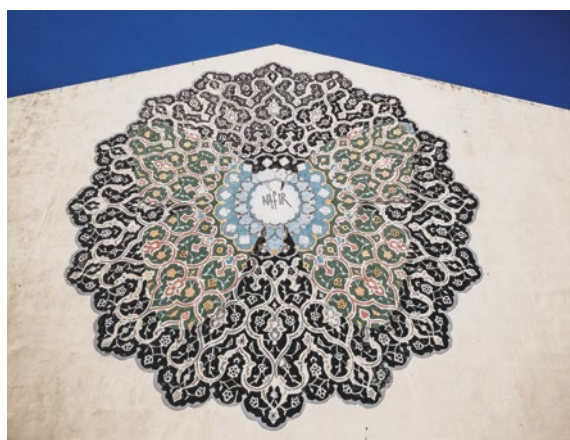

# THE OLDEST HINDU TEMPLE IN BUTTERWORTH

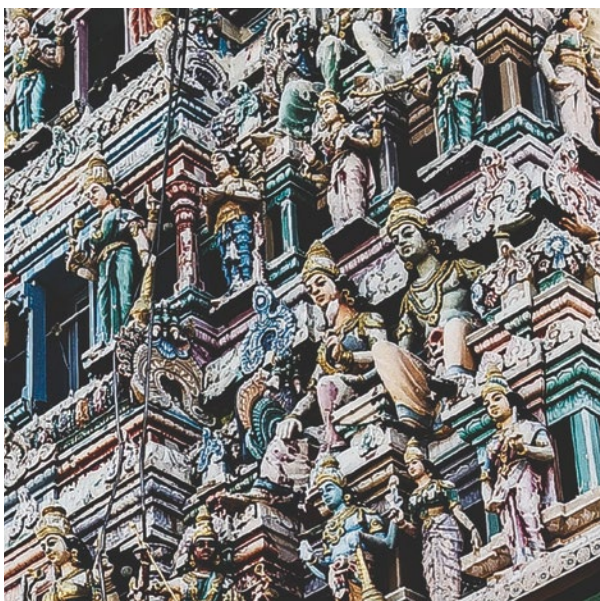
## SREE MAHA MARIAMMAN DEVASTHANAM TEMPLE



Vibrant in exterior and the biggest and oldest temple located in Bagan Luar, Butterworth, the Sree Maha Mariamman Devasthanam Temple is the temple for the Hindu community that dwells along Jalan Jeti Lama.

It is said that back in 1853, someone came across the statue of the principal deity Amman by the seaside. It was then placed and worshipped in a specially constructed hut before the Sree Maha Mariamman Devasthanam Temple was built in 1903.





Impressive sculptures adorn the walls of the temple, each being a representation of ancient Hindu mythology. It also has a stunning gopuram which towers over the building in vicinity.

Additionally, one can also visit Jalan Pasar, which is the road next to where the temple is. It is a street with a variety of eye-catching murals that will take you back to the old days!

The most famous Taoist temple in Butterworth, the Tow Boo Kong Temple, or known as the Nine Emperor Gods Temple is located at Raja Uda. The Tow Boo Kong Temple was first established back in 1970 with only palm tree leaves as its roof. Over the years, the shrine has undergone many makeovers and was finally completed in 2016.

The Nine Emperor Gods are commonly worshipped by the Fujian people in the southern provinces of China, but its popularity has declined since being exported out. In Penang, there are still many people who pay homage to these deities because of their ancestral roots.





The temple holds an impressive and colourful assortment of paintings, murals, sculptures and figures of Chinese mythical animals and heavenly warriors. These figures can be seen adorning the temple ceilings, pillars and walls. When the temple lights are lit up at night, the temple takes on an even more majestic view!

The temple is currently undergoing renovation to include a Nine Emperor Gods Cultural Museum, a library for Taoist history and a dormitory for devotees during the Nine Emperor Gods Festival.



Each year, the Tow Boo Kong Temple will celebrate the Nine Emperor Gods Festival for nine straight days from the first day to the ninth day of the ninth lunar month. During this period of time, devotees will observe a strict vegetarian diet.

Across these nine days, a variety of spectacular rituals such as the Fire Walking Ceremony and the Spear Skewing Ceremony can be seen at the temple. Many mediums can also be seen in action, as they are possessed by the Nine Emperor Gods and put in a meditative trance.

This festival reaches its climax on the ninth day, with devotees coming from near and far to participate in the procession to send the deities home.

# NIGHT AT RAJA UDA



Known as the Chinatown of Butterworth, Raja Uda is best known for its happening night scene. With a rich array of traditional Chinese temples, stunning streetscapes, markets, kopitiams (coffee-shops), modern pubs and hawker centres, it is paradise for anyone seeking adventure and good food!

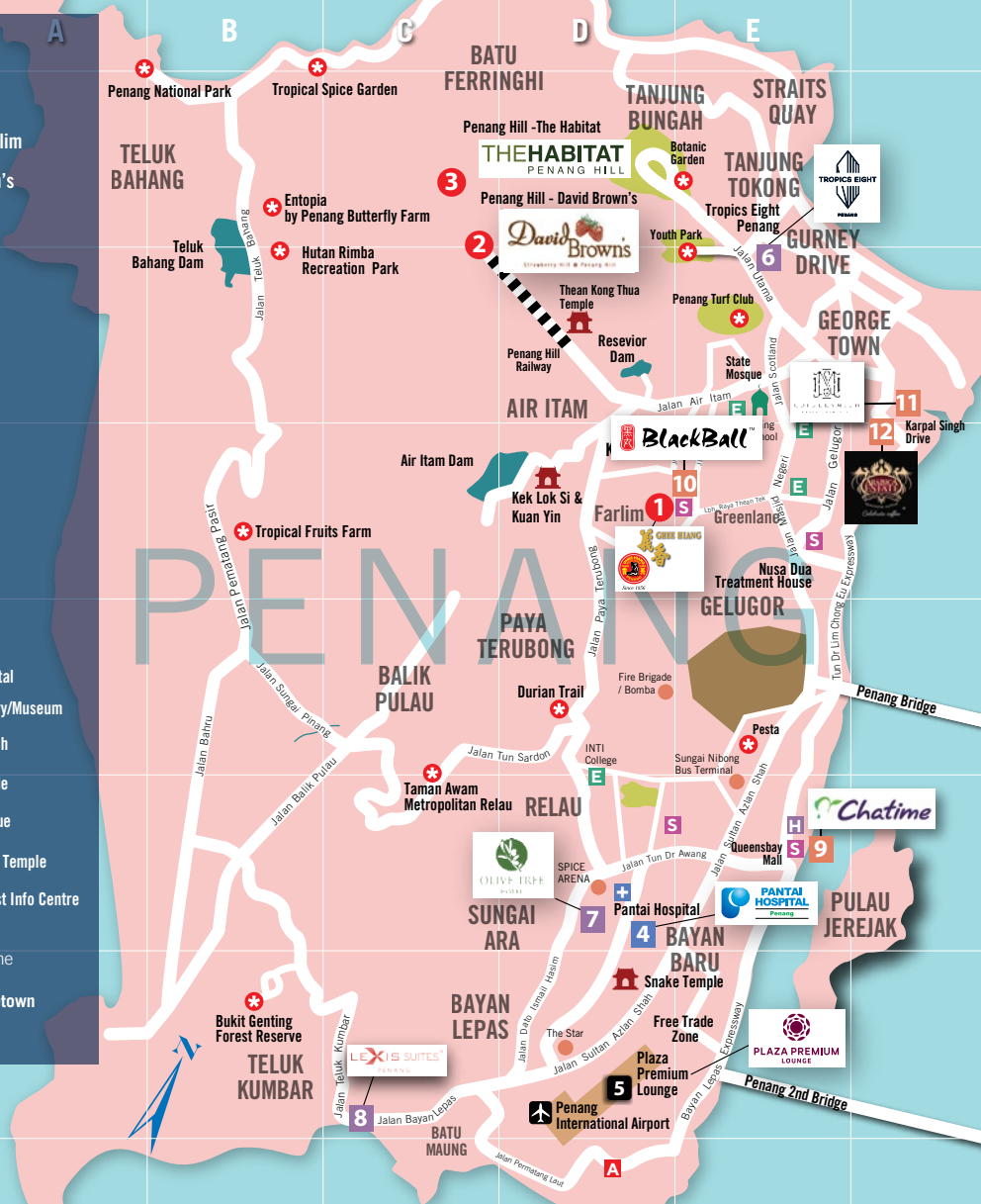

# PENANG SMART PARKING

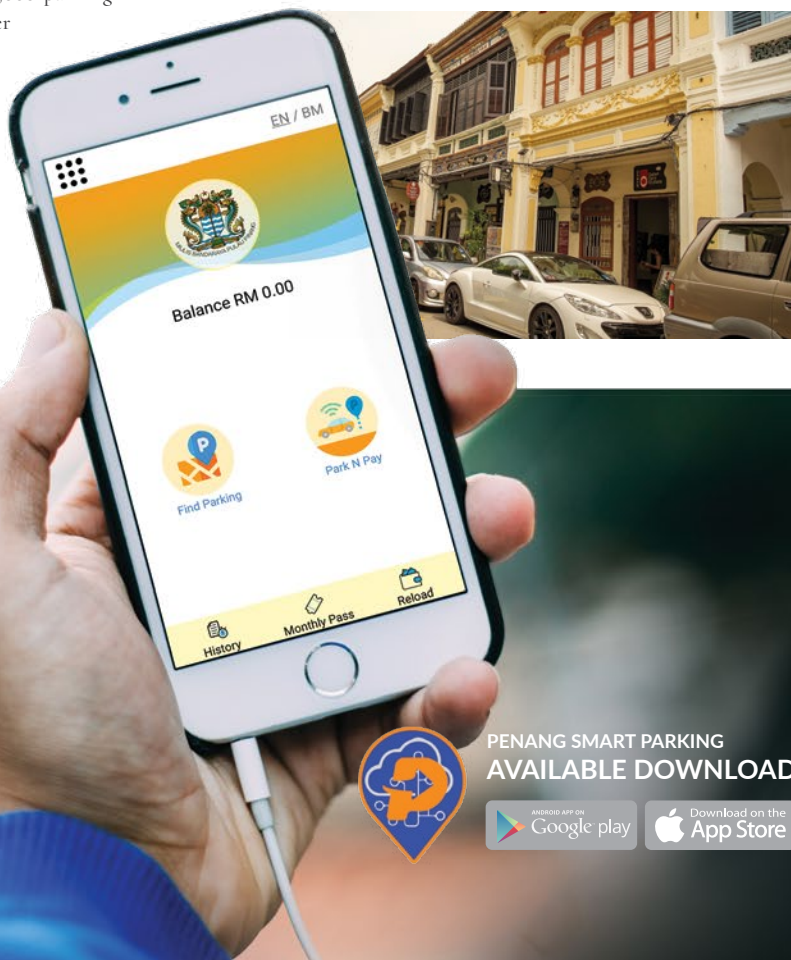
*Running out of parking coupons every time you find a parking spot is the greatest nuisance! To provide a solution to this matter, the Penang Smart Parking (PSP) app was launched by the state council. It is the first of its kind in the country with paper-based coupons unavailable after the 31st of December 2019. This means in 2020 the parking payment in Penang will be fully digital.*

This app is a great upgrade to the conventional way of using parking coupons. It eliminates the hassle of searching for parking coupon booths and the time consumed to scratch it when you are rushing for time. You can easily find parking around selected zones, reload your wallet and pay your parking and summon in no time! The Penang Smart Parking app is conveniently downloadable from Google Play and the Apple App Store.

This parking system implements a combination of Internet of Things (IoT), sensor technology, the online payment system and the navigation system. There are 36,000 parking bays in the state with 24,000 bays under the supervision of the Seberang Perai Municipal Council (SPMC) and 12,000 bays under the Penang City Council (PCC). Smart parking sensors will also be installed to monitor the entry and exit of vehicles.

One of the best features of this app is that it provides users with vacant parking spots based on real-time information. If parking spots in the area are full, the system will provide the user with the closest alternatives available.

The Penang Smart Parking is one of the many initiatives the Penang council has launched to strive towards becoming a smart state. Although it may be hard to adapt to this major change at the beginning, but with time this app holds great potential towards improving the future of Penang's transportation system.

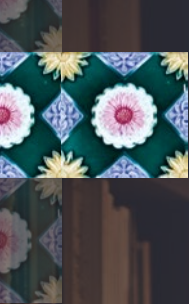
